## **ORDINANCE NO. 175**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COAHOMA, TEXAS, CONFIRMING A MAP OF THE CITY'S CURRENT CITY LIMIT BOUNDARIES AND EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION BOUNDARIES; PROVIDING FOR THE FILING OF THIS ORDINANCE WITH THE HOWARD COUNTY CLERK; PROVIDING THAT THE MAP SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE AT CITY HALL AND ON THE CITY'S WEBSITE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

## AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING AND ADOPTING THE CITY'S CITY LIMITS AND EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION MAP

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code Chapter 41 requires that the City of Coahoma, Texas ("City"), maintain an up-to-date map that shows the City's current city limit boundaries and current extraterritorial jurisdiction ("ETJ") boundary limits; and

WHEREAS, the City's city limits and ETJ boundary limits remain unchanged since the most recent voluntary annexations, approved by the Coahoma City Council on August 17, 2017 through the adoption of Ordinance Numbers 128 and 129, and on October 18, 2021 through the adoption of Ordinance Number 153; and

WHEREAS the City Council desires to adopt a map that shows the same city limit boundaries as were effective as of the latest annexation ordinances, and that reaffirms the City's city limits and ETJ boundary limits; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the City to adopt the map attached as *Exhibit A* as the current map of the city limits and the ETJ of the City and to cause such map to be made available at convenient locations as set forth in state law.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF COAHOMA, TEXAS THAT:

**Section 1.** The City Council hereby adopts the map attached hereto as *Exhibit A* as one that shows the City of Coahoma city limit boundaries and ETJ boundaries that were in effect on August 11, 2025, and reflects the Annexation History of the City as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

**Section 2.** The city limits and ETJ map adopted pursuant to this Ordinance, and any future such maps adopted by the City Council must contain the following notice:

This map is for informational purposes and may not have been prepared for or suitable

for legal, engineering, or surveying purposes. It does not represent an on-the-ground survey and represents only the approximate relative location of the property boundaries. All data provided represents current information as of the date shown on the map and is believed to be accurate, but the accuracy is not warranted.

**Section 2.** The City Secretary is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of Howard County, Texas, a certified copy of this Ordinance and the attached map.

**Section 3.** In accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 41.001, the map attached hereto as *Exhibit A* shall be made available to the public at no charge in the City Secretary's office at City Hall, and on the City's website.

**Section 4. Severability.** Should any part, portion, section or provision of this ordinance be declared to be invalid or inoperative or void for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision, opinion or judgment shall in no way affect the remaining parts, portions, sections or provisions of this ordinance which provisions shall remain and continue to be in full force and effect.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
