

On July 20, 2023 the Coahoma City Council met in regular session @ 6:00 P.M. at City Hall.

Motion was made by Sarah Willborn and seconded by Mark Richardson to approve the previous minutes. Motion carried 4-0.

Lanny King, Brandon Rodgers and Carla Bryant asked the council if it was possible to get water lines ran on Vikki Rd. Their wells are going dry. Options were discussed. Council would like to get Ray Seales to research the cost and if there will be enough water pressure. Council asked to have it added to the August agenda.

Peter Gonzales from Oncor introduced himself to the Council. He will be the replacement for Kristy Tyra.

Motion was made by Chris Mulkey and seconded by Eric Barber to deny the Oncor rate increase. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion was made by Eric Barber and seconded by Chris Mulkey to approve the additional language to the Rates Ordinance #161. The additional language consist of " Additional tap charges: If the service location for the tap necessitates additional labor or equipment charges such as for boring under a roadway, other obstruction or any other extenuating circumstance, the customer must pay such additional charges in advance based on a quote to be provided to the making of the tap." Motion carried 4-0.

Curfew ordinance was discussed.

Budget amendments: Create a new line item for the ariel spraying. Budget \$2500.00. Motion was made by Chris Mulkey and seconded by Eric Barber. Motion carried 4-0.

Splash pad was discussed. There will be 2 more features added in the fall.

Future agenda items: Taps on Vikki Rd.

Meetings will be changed to 3rd Tuesday @ 6:30 P.M. starting in August until further notice.

Motion was made by Eric Barber and seconded by Sarah Willborn to approve current bills. Motion carried 4-0.
