

ORDINANCE NO. 101

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COAHOMA, TEXAS REQUIRING RESIDENCY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COAHOMA TO SERVE ON THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COAHOMA AND VACATING SUCH POSITION UPON CHANGE OF RESIDENCY OUTSIDE OF THE CITY LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COAHOMA, TEXAS AS FOLLOWINGS:

Section 1. All aldermen for the City of Coahoma, whether elected or appointed, shall reside within the ward from which the alderman is elected or appointed to serve.


Section 2. If an alderman moves from the ward from which the alderman is **elected**, the alderman's office is considered vacant.

Section 3. If an alderman moves from the ward from which the alderman is **appointed**, the alderman's office is considered vacant.

Section 4. This ordinance shall apply to any and all aldermen elected or appointed after the passage of this ordinance and will not be applied retroactively to any currently serving aldermen.


Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval by the Mayor.

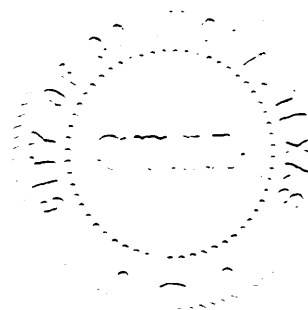


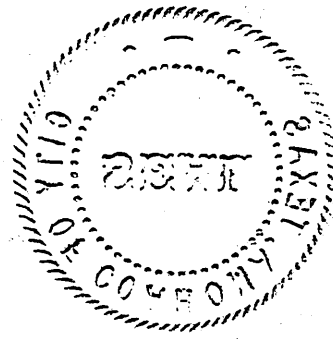
